

New Adverse Drug Reactions (ADR) Flow chart



Patient experiences a new ADR resulting in the patient presenting to hospital
OR the new ADR
occurs during the patient's hospital visit/stay.



Provide appropriate treatment for the ADR (e.g. antihistamine, MET CALL).
Cease the medication if appropriate or review the medication in consultation
with medical staff .



Update the ADR section on the medication chart, Clinical Alerts Manager (CAM)
and complete a Riskman.

The Medication Safety pharmacist or delegate will review the Riskman and:

- Complete an ADR letter which will be posted out to the patient/carer/GP
- Complete a Therapeutics Goods Administration (TGA) report, if the criteria is met
- Report to the Medication Safety and Therapeutics Committee (MSTC)
