Information for consumers

The Breastfeeding Support Services at Grampians Health (Ballarat and Horsham) offer information and support to women and families who are experiencing breastfeeding difficulties in the first few months following birth, or who simply want reassurance and advice about breastfeeding. Our services are staffed by experienced International Board Certified Lactation Consultants who can offer support and advice for a range of issues.

Advice during pregnancy

- Previous breast surgery.
- · Previous difficulties with breastfeeding.
- Medications and breastfeeding.
- Multiple pregnancy.
- Baby with a cleft lip and/or palate or other medical issues.
- Anything else which might cause breastfeeding challenges.

Support after your baby is born

- · Positioning and attachment.
- Sore nipples.
- · Concerns about milk supply.
- · Concerns about baby's weight.
- Medications and breastfeeding.
- Previous breast surgery.
- Feeding support for mothers with preterm or unwell babies.
- Feeding support for mothers of twins or triplets.
- Baby with cleft lip and/or palate.
- · Mastitis.
- Breast and nipple thrush.
- Tongue-tie.
- General breastfeeding support and information.

- Baby's Child Health Record (green book).
- Nappies, change of clothes for baby.

During this appointment the Lactation Consultant will watch your baby breastfeed so it's best if your baby is ready for a feed when you arrive.
